Principal's Report

In 2007-08 Bethany Christian Schools continued to serve the church and community by implementing its mission of integrating faith with academic excellence, equipping students for Christian discipleship in the church and around the world. At the same time, Bethany completed a two-year self-study/strategic planning process designed to position the school for continued excellence in Christian education for the 21st century.



Mission-focused: In Bible classes and chapels, through relationships with teachers and peers, and in extracurricular activities, students explored Christ's call on their lives, seeking a faith they could own. For instance, students considered the biblical theme of justice in chapels, theater productions, Spring Arts Day, and Spiritual Life Week. Students also continued to excel academically as their exceptionally strong SAT and ISTEP scores demonstrated.

Community: Students developed meaningful relationships with each other and with teachers as adult Christian mentors who encouraged them to develop a Christ-centered worldview and to own the values of discipleship, peacemaking, and service. Middle school students grew their relationship skills through the new SHARE program, while high school students developed leadership skills through hands-on practice and mentoring by teachers in the Leadership Development Program.

Having hosted international students for decades, Bethany last year opened its William Violett House as a residence for five international students. Capable and dedicated house parents Sarah and Matt Moyer cultivated a warm Christian family setting for them.

New accreditations: Accredited since its inception in 1954 by Indiana's Department of Education, Bethany earned two new accreditations last year. Following their site visit in March, both the North Central Association and the Mennonite Education Agency granted full accreditation—commending Bethany for fostering a dynamic learning community, maximizing students' success, demonstrating strong commitment to Anabaptist-Mennonite education and distinctives, and completing the *Validating the Vision* self-study in an exemplary manner.

Continued excellence for the 21st century: The fundamental goal of the self-study was to position Bethany for continued excellence in the 21st century. The many surveys, meetings, visioning events and conversations of the past two years culminated in an "Action Plan for School Improvement, 2007-2012" that identifies four priority areas: programming, professional development, finances, and church and community relations. An illustration of the thoroughness of last year's work is the comprehensive review of the music program, on the basis of which the program is now being redesigned. The Bethany community sees significant potential in the priorities for making our fine school even better—in particular, to equip students for Christian discipleship in a rapidly changing world.

This past year Bethany achieved a number of important milestones—none of which would have been possible without the support and participation of many.

- In mid-year the school paid off in full the mortgage on the recent middle school capital building project. A particular blessing was the high 98% rate of pledge satisfaction, tangible evidence of constituents' exceptional support.
- The 18-member Advisory Council completed its work, having made a significant contribution to the success of the capital campaign and building project.
- Bethany's two-year self-study/strategic planning process engaged a wide spectrum of Bethany constituents in conversation about the school's future.
