Stats in Sports with Daniel Mast (12 students)

In this interterm, students will learn how to keep "book" in certain sports, what stats mean and how they are calculated. They will have a chance to practice taking stats, and gain a deeper understanding of how numbers impact athletics and performance. (half day)

Mirrors & Windows with Jared Leaman and Matt Miller (24 students)

Reading and writing give us ways to explore and express ourselves and our interests. At the same time, we can explore and relate to stories of diverse and inspiring people. In this Interterm, we will explore some of our favorite things - like the winter pastimes of hot chocolate, snow forts or basketball. We will visit bookstores like The Brain Lair in South Bend and Fables here in Goshen. We will fill little libraries around town with books that inspire us and get to take home a few books of our own! I Can Help with Linda Hochstetler (12 students)

In this interterm you will learn basic first aid! You will be prepared to help others! We will learn to take care of common issues that require first aid - such as nose bleeds, hypothermia, hyperthermia, minor cuts, bites, dizziness, and ankle/wrist sprains. You will also learn how and why a backboard is used. Additionally, you will be able to before CERTIFIED in CPR! This would be a good interterm for those of you who have interest in camping, hiking, or childcare. These skills are important for all of us to master! (half day)

Sports Card Collecting 101 with Hank Willems (12 students)

80s Pop Culture with Aaron Johnson (12 students)
