Interterm III Offerings

March 8-10, 2023

Disney Re-imagined with Benji Hurst

Students will watch, review and discuss three Disney classic animated movies and their corresponding live-action remakes. The class includes a private screening of one of the films and a behind the scenes tour of the historic Goshen Theater.

Opera Experience (1 night) with Danielle Svonavec

We will study the musical style of Baroque opera, particularly Handel's opera Xerxes. Will will travel to Detroit Friday to see a performance. We will need to stay overnight in Detroit.

Soccer Refereeing with Edgar Silva

In this course we will study the most important definitions, rules, and mechanics students need to take the first step into becoming a soccer or "fútbol" referee. We will have labs, classwork to learn how to referee games, pick up games, and we will take the exam together on Day 3. Come and join this course if you want to get your license and start making (lots of) money; want to learn the game better, or just simply enjoy about the beautiful game.

March Madness (1 night) with Brent Reinhardt

March Madness is all things basketball. Students will learn basketball history, create an expansion NBA franchise, and other basketball topics. This Includes a trip to the Men's Big Ten Tournament in Chicago.

Being Well with Michael Walker

Students will explore multiple aspects of health and wellness - physical, mental, social, emotional, and spiritual. We will practice tangible strategies for all of these, and students will create a personal plan with strategies to use in their daily life by the end of the class.

Practical Household Skills with Michael Yeakey

Students will learn basic drywall, painting, minor household construction, and electrical skills in a variety of environments.

Local Service with Leon Bauman

During Local Service we will visit local non-profit agencies to learn about what they do for our community and help out while we are there.

Things that Fly 2.0 (continuing from Interterm 2) with Calvin Swartzendruber

If it flies, we'll play with it! Design, build, and launch your own model rocket. Try your hand at flying the school's DJI Phantom 3 drone. Earn your recreational drone pilot's certificate. Ride the simulators at the AirZoo and tour an airplane factory. And if that's not enough, take a helicopter ride and then get a short flight lesson while you are at the controls of a real plane at the Goshen airport! This interterm meets all three interterms (#1, 2, 3). There will be several day trips; no overnight travel. *(Sign-up has already occurred and students will continue from Interterm 2.)*

Mural Painting with Christa Janzen

The Mural Interterm group will be designing, drawing and painting 1-2 murals inside the school building. Students need to have strong drawing and design skills and enjoy painting. Get ready to be a part of making a lasting impression on BCS! *(Sign up for this interterm has already occurred.)*

History of Rock and Roll with Aaron Johnson

Students will learn about the origins and progression of Rock music, beginning with the rise of Rock and Roll, and continuing up to today's music. Students will do research on a rock band of their choosing, and will get a chance to explore the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland, Ohio.

Interterm 4 - May 31-June 2

Students will be introduced to different types of cycling over a two-interterm period.

In January, students will be introduced to different aspects of cycling culture, do some indoor training, visit a velodrome, and plan for a summer bicycle camping trip. **In the post-school-year interterm, we will take a self-supported bicycle tour through northern Indiana and southern Michigan.**
