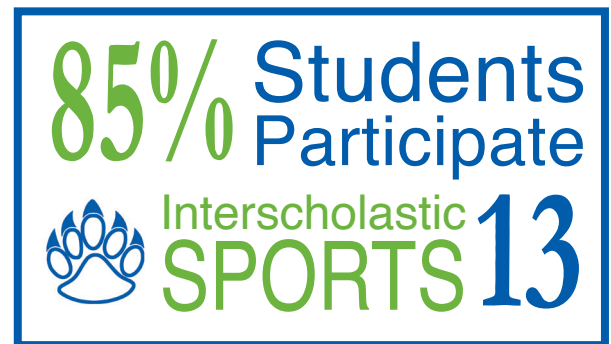

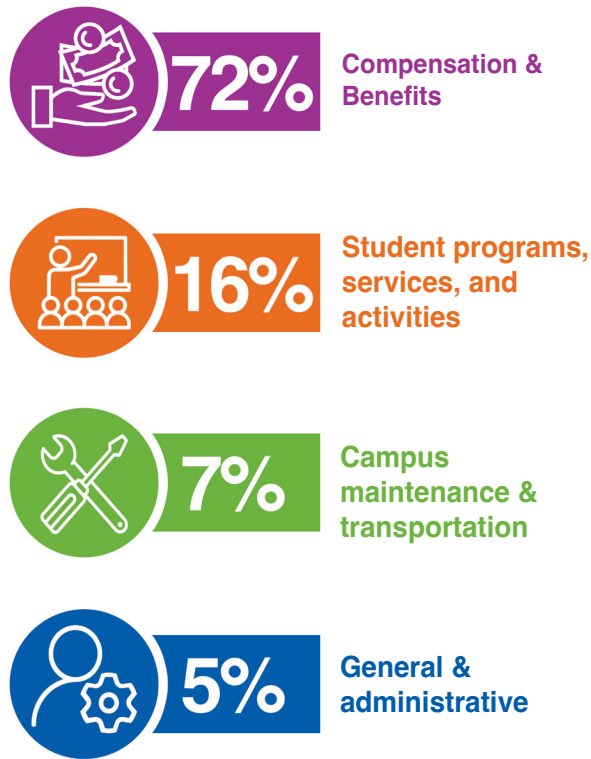

Thanks to hard work, commitment, and the pursuit of excellence throughout his high school career, senior James Lind will head to college next fall with a full scholarship worth nearly \$350,000!

During James' junior year, he started the process of applying for college through QuestBridge. In this

program, high-achieving high school seniors from low-income backgrounds are connected with full four-year scholarships from 50 of the nation's best colleges. This program is familiar to the Lind family, as James' older sister Clara ('20) applied through the same program, became a finalist, and received generous financial aid for her post-secondary education at Bryn Mawr. James learned he was a finalist in October, and then on December 1, he was notified of his full matching scholarship to Colby College.

James said, "When I was younger, I lived in New Hampshire and I really love that part of the country. Colby was one of my top five schools. Interestingly, the school runs on 100% green energy, and I like that about the college. The relationship they are maintaining with the environment is important to me." James thinks Colby was interested in him partly because his essay referenced Colby's values of clean energy with his own desire to pursue a degree in engineering.

Krysten Parson, school counselor, is very happy for James, and says, "I am not surprised James received

the full scholarship. He is an all-around good kid and deserves this opportunity."

The future for James is set for the next four years, but it was the solid training he received at Bethany and his ability to leverage his grades to pay for his future training and career that makes this such a testament to Bethany's programs and staff.

James was in 4th grade when he started attending Bethany, joining the community with his older sister Clara ('20) and mother Sarah (staff '13-23). His father, Matt, is also an alum of the class of 1995.

James developed a love of science and math at Bethany, giving thanks and praise to teachers Calvin Swartzendruber, Amy Thut, and Renae Yoder. His success and enjoyment of these subjects led to his desire to pursue engineering in college.

Beyond academics, James plays alto saxophone in band and loves to participate in extracurriculars. He has been in the Student Government Association (SGA) and is president of Bethany's Key Club. In both, he enjoys working with the other students in organizing events for student socials, dances, and volunteer activities. James has experienced success in athletics as well – playing tennis, basketball, track and field, baseball, and soccer. This past fall, he was the sportsmanship and defensive leader for Bethany's historic IHSAA 1A boys soccer state championship team.



"It was such an amazing opportunity to win the state soccer title," James reflects. "I'm really proud to be a part of the team and the sense of community and support we had."

We look forward to hearing about the success James will experience at Colby College and are proud to have

him join the ranks of amazing Bethany alumni!

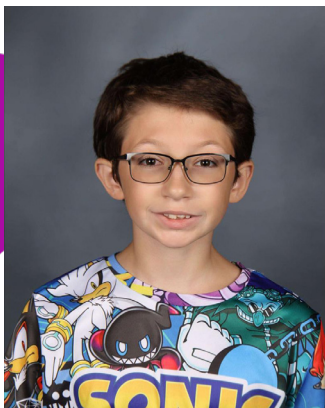
